Works progress report: telephone line relocation.

W/c. 1st June: Highridge Green, A38 and King George's Road.

In order to relocate utility services, we shall be installing underground ducts for British Telecom cables. The work will require the closure of the footpath in successive 100m sections, over a month, along both, Highridge Common and on the A38 Bridgewater Road. Safe pedestrian diversions around these section will be provided. The work will then proceed across the junction between Highridge Road and King George's Road, with the installation of temporary, 4-way traffic lights **from the 10th of June for a fortnight**. Throughout the work access to all properties will be maintained.

W/c 1st June 2015: on the A38, about halfway between the King's Head roundabout and the Town and Country Lodge Hotel, temporary 2-way traffic signals and 30mph speed limits will operate for two weeks from 09:30am to 3:30pm.

Reserved corridor, Bishopsworth.

Site boundary fencing will be installed from the 1st week in June and will remain in place throughout this phase of the works. Excavators will then begin to work on the new carriageway.
