Introduction & Progress Update

As many of you will be aware Griffiths have been appointed by Anglesey County Council to construct the first two phases of the Llangefni Link Road.

The new Llangefni Link Road, to the east of the town will, once fully complete on all four sections, link the Grŵp Llandrillo Menai Penraig campus to the A5114 at the Lon Glanhwfa/ Industrial Estate Road junction and will act as a catalyst for a number of significant economic development benefits to the area. Most notably, it will enable the growth and expansion of the college campus and provide improved access to the Enterprise Zone sites. Additionally, the scheme will improve linkages with the A55 and help overcome traffic constraints in Llangefni.

Progress Update

The project is now very close to completion with 100% of the tarmac base now laid and the kerbing complete. Our landscaping contractor is progressing and the fencing and planting alongside the new highway is well underway. The road closure for 5 days last month enabled the tie in areas around the new roundabout on Lon Penmynydd to be prepared for the final surfacing which will commence in early February 2017.

Archaeological Update

Analysis is continuing at Cardiff University on the excavated remains and future updates will be made by Anglesey County Council when information becomes available.

Upcoming works

As the new highway nears completion there are only a number of key stages to be completed. These include the final surfacing and white lining, erection of signs and street lighting in the areas around the roundabouts. In order to facilitate these aspects a final road closure on the B5420 Lon Penmynydd will be required in early February 2017. This work should take no more than a week and details of the road closure will be advertised closer to the time.

Planting at Section 1, adjacent to Meithrinfa Medra will be undertaken in the New Year.



Landscaping the Llangefni Link Road, Sections 1 & 2

As mentioned our landscaping contractor is currently planting trees and shrubs alongside the new Link Road. These are made up of a wide variety but include Scots Pine, Common Beech, Common Alder, Common Oak and Sweet Chestnut trees and will replace those taken down alongside the B5420 during site clearance. The hedgerows will include a mix of Hazel, Hawthorn, Holly, Sloe and many more different species. Over 11,000 trees and shrubs will be planted with 426 of these being established trees over 175cm in height.
