**Re: Boverton Flood Alleviation Scheme**

As part of our commitment to working with the local community and in order to effectively deliver the Boverton Flood Alleviation Scheme; we would like to update you on scheme progress and inform you of some upcoming community drop in sessions.

Progress Update:

Griffiths have made significant progress with Statutory undertakers diversions and are programmed to complete the Phase 1 works early to mid-October which encompasses the installation of Northern section of the new culvert . Completion of this work has entailed significant Engineering and construction requirements noting specifically the breaking out of the existing highway, the removal of the upstream section of the existing culvert, fluming of the watercourse, piling works and the installation of the new concrete liner walls.

In preparation of Phase 2 works to the Southern Carriageway, we are currently undertaking primary service diversions which includes both foul and surface water diversions together with concrete finishing works to the culvert soffit in readiness for carriageway construction parapet works.

It is our intention to complete the enabling works within phase 2 over the next few weeks which will facilitate the re-opening of Eagleswell Road and require the closing of Boverton Road from Eagleswell Road heading towards Boverton Brook.

Phase 2 works will effectively mirror those operations previously undertaken within Phase 1 which will require the closure of the Northern carriageway, enabling the removal of the second half of the existing culvert, encompassing a temporary fluming of the river which enables commencement of piling works within the southern phase.

Drop in Sessions:

We would like to take this opportunity to invite you to attend a community drop in session. At this session you will be able to see details of the works, the intended construction phases together with our intentions to reduce and minimise disruption to all affected parties. Representatives from Griffiths will be available to answer any concerns which you may have.
