Current Road Closures

Preparatory work for the new retaining wall and cycle/footpath in Lufton is well underway. Lufton Way has been closed eastbound between Preston Road (behind the Crematorium) and the Preston Road/ASDA Roundabout. Traffic can access Lufton Way at the ASDA/Preston Road Roundabout but cannot exit there.

Junction widening at Copse Road is ongoing but does not affect traffic flows.

Progress

Carriageway widening work is ongoing at the Westlands Roundabout and pedestrian management is in place whilst this work progresses.

A 30 mile per hour speed limit has been installed along the Yeovil Western Corridor between the Lysander Roundabout and the Copse Road junction.

Finishing works at the Bluebell Roundabout include road markings and the commissioning of the traffic lights. The lights are going through a programming and testing phase before they are commissioned in early August.

Work continues on the verges near the ASDA store where a temporary mini roundabout and pedestrian crossing have been installed to minimise disruption to road and footpath users.

Lighting columns are being erected along the length of the cycle/footpath through the Abbey Manor Estate.

Upcoming Works

Work to install ducting and drainage along the Western Relief Road and the removal of the Lysander Roundabout will commence on 6th August. Four-way traffic lights will be in operation overnight between 7.30pm and 6am, Monday to Friday for two weeks.

Carriageways will be reduced on all approaches to the Westlands Roundabout starting on 6th August for the duration of the school holidays (capacity in Bunford Lane and on the A3088 is already reduced).

The current carriageway closure in Lufton Way will switch to Western Avenue (southbound only - Houndstone Roundabout towards the ASDA Roundabout). This is expected to commence on 28th August but will be confirmed nearer the time. A diversion route will be signed.

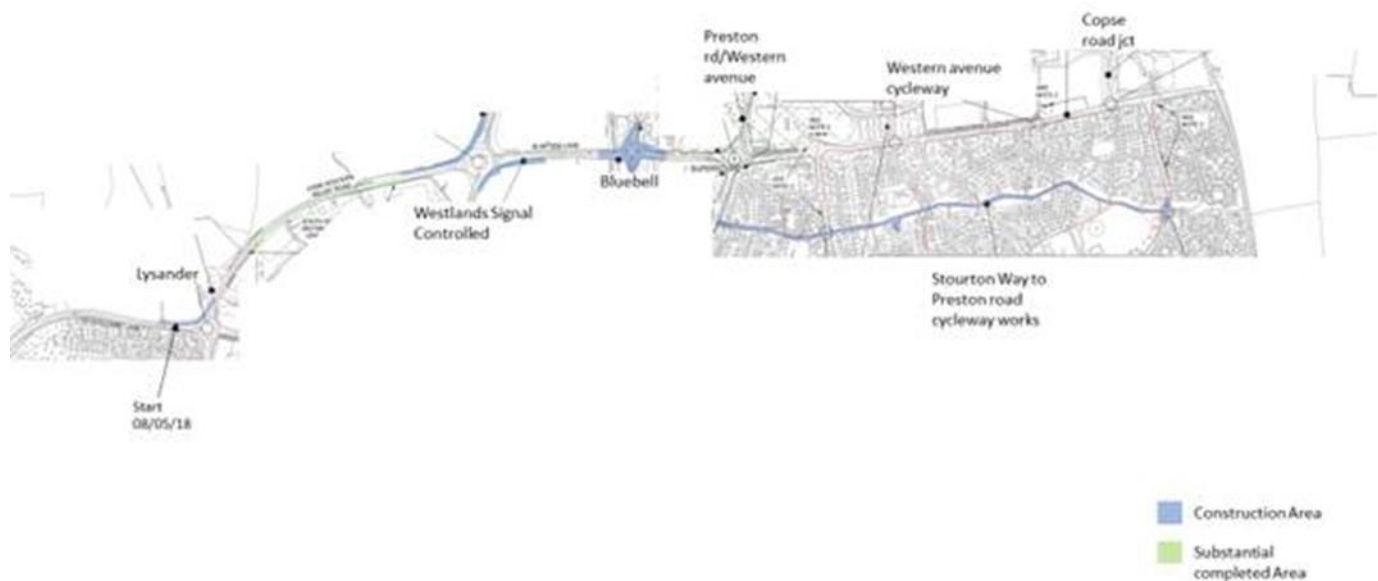
Ongoing & Upcoming Works cont'd...

A high friction surface is being installed at the two new pedestrian/cycle crossings on Stourton Way. Work on the southern crossing near Long Mead will start in the next two weeks and the final surface at the northern crossing near Forde Park will follow.

Bollards with cycle signage are to be installed in the next few weeks along the cycle/pedestrian path through the Abbey Manor Estate.
