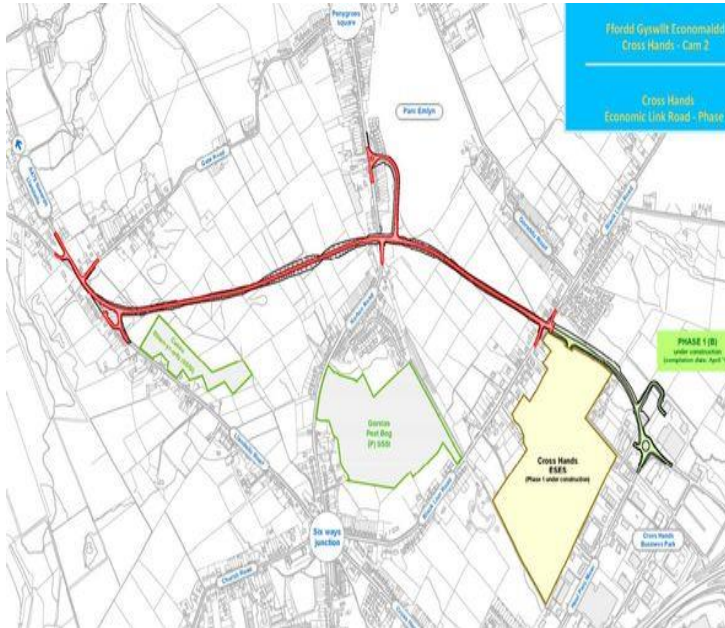


# Cross Hands Economic Link Road (Phase 2)

## Initial Construction Bulletin January 2018



Alun Griffiths (Contractors) Ltd. (Griffiths) are pleased to have been appointed Principal Contractor by Carmarthenshire County Council to construct Phase 2 of the Cross Hands Economic Link Road.

We have started preliminary construction works and the new link road is expected to be completed by December 2019.

The road will serve the Cross Hands East Strategic Employment Site.

The route extends northwards from Black Lion Road to Norton Road and on to the A476 north east of Gorslas.

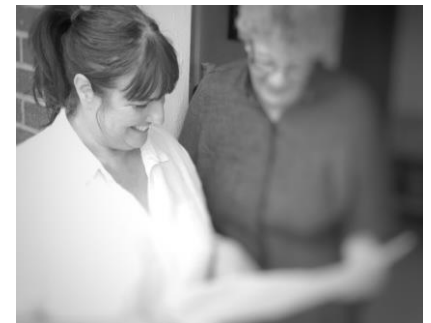
It will provide direct access from the north to the Cross Hands East Strategic Employment Site and will relieve congestion at the main A48 Cross Hands Roundabout and improve safety at the 'six ways' junction, Gorslas Square.
