In September, we will be launching an online facility: 'Experience, Educate, Engage,' developed by local company Aspire2Be. The materials are currently being translated and will be available to all schools in Wales on Hwb and the project has the support of the Welsh Government. One element of the Go Construct Educate programme is the opportunity for schools to invite a speaker from industry to visit and enhance the learning experience bringing the world of work into the classroom.

The car park above, located opposite the Construction Wales Innovation Centre has involved the laying of over 1000m<sup>2</sup> of block paviours (paving stones) with around 80m of stainless-steel handrail. Landscaping has including the planting of over 40 trees.



Works to the promontory featured in the right-hand side of the above photograph has been reinforced with over 12 tonnes of steel and the walls are formed using 67m<sup>3</sup> of concrete. Where possible Griffiths employees work at SA1 with local contractors and suppliers appointed to support on site activities. As at other areas of SA1 benches and street furniture will complete the aspect of this area which in the future can be used as a viewing platform.
