Project Update

Despite the high volume of rain which has fallen over the past few months, we continue to make good progress on site.

The excavation works to form the footprint of the new road between Woolavington Road and Hillside is nearing completion.

To protect the exposed ground, we are placing a layer of stone capping as we go.



The junction of Puriton Hill Road onto the A39 is now closed. This will enable us to undertake alterations to existing electrical and water supplies, necessary to complete land and highway drainage works and the new road which will link Puriton Hill Road to the New Roundabout.

There are now two temporary speed limits in place:

- 20mph on Woolavington Road and Hillside
- 30mph on A39 from Junction 23 of the M5 to just past the junction of Hillside.

These temporary speed limits are necessary to protect our workforce and will be in place for the next few weeks. We thank you for your patience during this time.

Upcoming works

- Western Power to commence alterations and diversions of the overhead cables running through the site and Puriton Hill.
- Construction Tie-in works between the New Road and Hillside.
- Continued installation of Highways Drainage on the New Road
