Alun Griffiths (Contractors) Ltd have been appointed by YGC (Gwynedd Council) as the Principal Contractor to carry out work on the Rhostryfan Flood Alleviation Scheme.

You will be aware that work started in the centre of the village on Saturday 18th July and will continue for a period of 15 weeks, however every effort will be made to complete this work sooner.

During this time the road leading through the village of Rhostryfan, from the A487 Ffrwd Cae Du towards Rhosgadfan, will be closed to all traffic at the the village centre with access being maintained at all times to properties in Bro Wyled, Bro Gilbert, Cae'r Eglwys and the surrounding area.

Unfortunately it has become immediately apparent that this road closure will need to be amended, under an emergency road closure notice, following the discovery of an unchartered foul sewer at the junction leading from the direction of Ffrwd Cae Du to the Bro Wyled area which must be diverted before further work can be carried out.

As a result, from Monday morning 27th July for approximately two weeks, access to and from the A487 will be through the village of Rhos Isaf.
