Progress Update

Good progress has been made to date. Following environmental and archaeological searches we have now established our site compound and commenced groundworks which have been divided into three phases. Phase 1 includes the long stretch from our compound near the entrance to the Dyson campus and out eastwards towards the A429 running parallel with the Hullavington Road.

To reduce the environmental impact of the work, we will be using locally sourced aggregates to construct the new road and all topsoil will remain on site for final landscaping works.

The below photo, which was taken from the A429 looking down Phase 1 on 17th August, shows the sub-structure of the new road and is just one layer of surfacing from finished levels.
