Alun Griffiths (Contractors) Ltd have been appointed by YGC (Gwynedd Council) as the Principal Contractor to carry out work on the Rhostryfan Flood Alleviation Scheme.

Further to our letter dated 21st August 2020, we have listened to the concerns of residents regarding accessibility to their homes and as a result we will be changing our working methods to ensure that vehicular access is maintained whilst the additional work is carried out at the junction to Bro Wyled. Road plates will be installed when access is required but please be aware that installation can take up to 10 minutes each time, therefore we would appreciate any advance warning, where possible.

The work will commence this week, but at present we cannot predict how long this work will take, as it will be dependant on the amount of times the work will need to stop to allow vehicular access. It is expected that, following the start of this work, the junction will be temporarily re-opened at the end of each day.

Please be assured that we have liaised with the emergency services to ensure that immediate access is available for emergency vehicles.

We apologise for the inconvenience that this work will undoubtedly cause and ask that you contact us as soon as possible should you have any specific access needs during this time. Please be assured that we will be ensuring that the works are done as quickly and safely as possible to allow the junction to be reopened fully.
