

Abergele flood prevention work (Phase 1)

Work starts: 18 January 2021

Work finishes: 18 June 2021

We are pleased to let you know that we are starting work to improve flood prevention for Abergele.

What is happening?

We will be carrying out work on the stream at Abergele Golf Course and Manorafon Farm to install:

- new culverts
- a trash screen (which will prevent debris from blocking the stream)
- open ditches
- a large storm water holding pond

The work will also include temporarily pumping and diverting streams, felling trees, and landscaping work.

Site vehicles will use the exit out of Manorafon Farm to get onto Abergele Road.
