## **Re: Gaer Fort Active Travel Cycle Path - Newport**

*Griffiths* have been appointed as the Principal Contractor by Newport City Council to construct a 1.4km cycle path through Gaer Fort, Newport.

Our works are due to begin on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> April 2021 and are anticipated to take approximately 12 weeks to complete. The main aim of the scheme is to encourage Active Travel by connecting Bassaleg Road at the North-West and Wells Close at the South-East.

We would also like to inform residents that from Monday 29<sup>th</sup> March 2021, we will be setting up our site compound at the end of Wells Close, leading onto and including a small area of the open space on Gaer Fort. Please be assured that access to properties and businesses will be maintained as well as pedestrian access in the surrounding areas. We are aware that Gaer Fort is extensively used by dog walkers and for leisure activities and exercise purposes, therefore signage will be made available to advise all users of the ongoing works.

Our working hours will be 08.00 - 17.00 (Monday-Friday) and 08.00-13.00 on weekends (if required). These hours are subject to change and all works are weather dependant.
