

Dear Resident/Business Owner,

**Rowbarton full signals refurbishment**

The main installation of traffic signals apparatus on the project is now reaching completion, and we are now commencing the final stages of the works which includes resurfacing, white lining, and high friction surfacing.

To safely deliver the resurfacing works we will need to implement full road closures, phased throughout the scheme over the next 5 weeks.

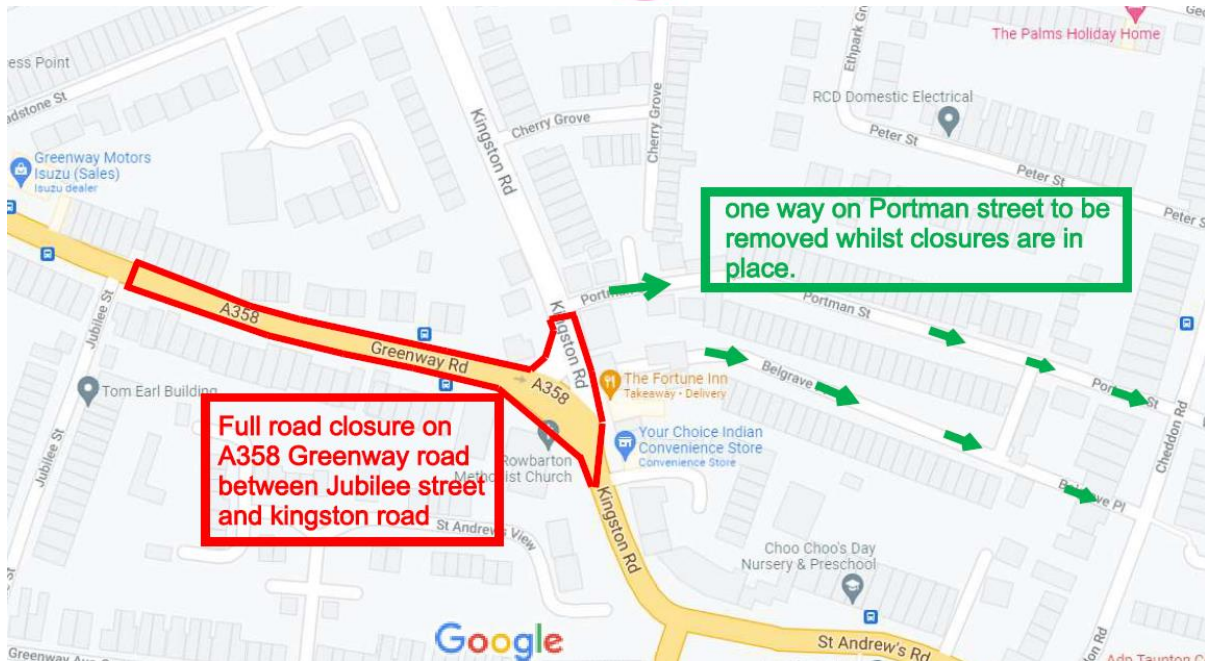
Phase 1 requires 5 evenings of closures, 3 evenings (18:00-02:00) on Greenway Road, to allow for the removal of the existing road surface, including the parking bays, which should be returned to service at the close of shift on Wednesday evening, 8<sup>th</sup> September.

The parking Bays will be taken out of service during the day on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September, to allow the prompt commencement of works at 18:00, We kindly ask for your cooperation with the removal of your vehicles, as this will allow the team to promptly proceed with the noisy removal of the existing carriageway early in the evening and complete the works around 23:00.

We intend to return the parking bays to use on Thursday morning and permit resident access only through the evening closures on Thursday and Friday evening.

The closure will remain on the junction of Kingston Road and Greenway Road for a further 2 nights (9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> October),

During the closure it is necessary to remove the one-way restriction on Portman Street, between 18:00 and 00:00, from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> to Friday 10<sup>th</sup> only. When the closures are removed the one way system must still be adhered.
